



Scholarship Application for Summer School 2017

Summer school is available to all high school students for the purpose of credit recovery and/or advancement. Summer school can be used to help students get on track for graduation, complete credits needed due to release time, or assist students in fulfilling requirements needed for early graduation. Students that are applying for a scholarship to cover some/part of the tuition must meet the minimum requirements outlined below and complete the attached Scholarship Application for Summer School. Awarded scholarships are redeemable for **one summer school session** of your choosing (pending availability). The amount of scholarships awarded is dependent on the funding available through the 21st Century Community Learning Center Grant (after-school tutoring program).

**** Please note that transportation is NOT included in the scholarship. ****

Summer School: Monday June 5th – Thursday June 29th [Monday – Thursdays]

AM Session: 7 – 11am OR PM Session: 11:30 – 3:30pm

Scholarship Eligibility:

For the free/reduced summer school scholarship, students must have been enrolled at Combs High School during the 2016-2017 school year. Scholarship awards are determined by the Combs High School staff and the following criteria will be considered:

- 1) Family income;
- 2) Participation in after-school tutoring (number of days attended and productivity);
- 3) Parent involvement (it is encouraged that parents have attended at least two academic events/meetings at CHS this year) – please see suggestions on back;
- 4) Student commitment and effort during the school year; and
- 5) Students' credit needs.

**** Priority will be given to students that have put forth effort and shown improvement throughout the school year.**

Requirements:

1. Complete the Scholarship Application for Summer School (be sure to answer all questions!).
2. Parent and student signatures on Summer School Commitment Contract.
3. Return completed application to the main office no later than **Friday April 28th**.

Students will be notified of their scholarship in writing (a letter will be sent home with students) no later than **Friday May 5th**.

		All summer school classes are conducted online using Edgenuity.
		Attendance is mandatory. After 3 absences (excused or unexcused), students will be dropped from the class and no credit will be earned.
		Students are expected to work an average of 60 minutes per day at home. If internet is not available at home, families are encouraged to make alternative arrangements with friends or a public library (Queen Creek or Apache Junction) for internet access.
		Summer school classes are rigorous, and students must come prepared to work.
		One class must be completed before students start on a second class.
		Teachers will update progress at least once per week on Jupiter. Parents are responsible for ensuring that they are checking their students' progress via Jupiter.
